## The Christians' Hour broadcast now features three great speakers !

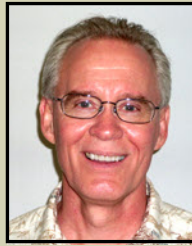

## Congratulations & Happy Anniversary To NRB!

The National Religious Broadcasters is a non-partisan, international association of Christian communicators whose member organizations represent millions of listeners, viewers, and readers. In addition to promoting standards of excellence, integrity, and accountability, they provide networking, educational, ministry, and fellowship opportunities for members.

James DeForest Murch, an NRB founding member (died 1973) was also a founder and trustee of the Christians' Hour Broadcasting Association (now GBM-TCH), and we are still members today. Murch was also founder or co-founder of the North American Christian Convention, the Disciples of Christ Historical Society and was managing editor of Christianity Today who called him, "one of its most influential evangelical leaders." He wrote an excellent book: "Christians Only" which is a history of the Restoration Movement (check with amazon.com).
